



GIG (Girl Investment Group) Registration Form

Welcome to the first step of setting up a GIG!

This document will help you:

- Understand different elements of the program, pieces of information to collect and what they are for (**Glossary of Terms, Page 1-2**)
- Collate names and contact details of each member of your GIG (**GIG Roll Call Table, Page 3**)
- Decide when and where your group would like to meet for an initial 'housekeeping' catch up (**Page 4**)

Glossary of Terms

The following are explanations of the different decisions you will need to make and the preferences you will need to collect from each GIG member:

Organiser Girl

You are the key contact for your group and most of the communications between 10thousandgirl will be with you for you to distribute to the GIG members.

Group Size

We recommend that GIGs have between 6-8 members. This size gives you all a good balance between learning and sharing together.

Length of Program

The 10thousandgirl Campaign Personal Finance Program runs fortnightly over 6 months or monthly over 12 months. There are 12 modules to explore.

Length of Each Module

Each module takes between 2.5-3 hours to complete, depending on the amount of time discussion points take.

Preferred Time

The modules are ideally held one evening after work. If your GIG prefers a day on the weekend to get together, that's fine too. If you decide to hold your meetings on a weekday, it's recommended the group agrees on a time that people can arrive not overly rushed from work.

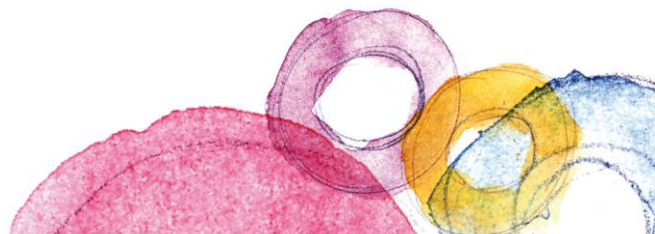

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Preferred Start Month

You may be ready to start straight away once all your member are organised and have completed their individual registrations or you may want to start in a month's time. **Make sure you first organise a 'housekeeping' catch up to meet each other, distribute the folders and consolidate your 'house rules'. The agenda for this initial catch up is in your folders.** Please note that once we have received the Group registrations, it may take up to 10 days for the folder and welcome package to reach your GIG.

Suggested Place

You may opt for a GIG member's work place or someone's home. Make sure it is a space that is relatively quiet so you can have easy discussions and has a computer with internet access to watch the module videos. You may want to rotate between homes each month or someone may wish to regularly host it.

Monthly or Upfront Payment Option

Each member may be different. A payment plan may suit some girls, while others may want to take advantage of the upfront discount and get the administration out of the way. Paying upfront saves us time and resources that we can use to further develop programs and to deliver to areas that can't afford to pay. If you can afford to pay up front it's appreciated.

Name of GIG

This is a fun part – come up with a name for your unique GIG. Are you *'The Savvy Investors'* or *'Giving Back the Love Club'*? This will help us identify you and set your group up on the Opportunity International micro-site (the micro-site is a place where we will be publishing your microfinance contributions from your course fees. The site allows you to watch your GIG's fundraising efforts grow and contribute extra funds should you choose to).

General

- It's best to work with what the majority wants in terms of the preferences and to be as inclusive as possible.
- If you lock the preferred dates and times such as the 3rd Wednesday of every month or every 2nd Wednesday, then everyone can lock it in their diaries going forward.
- You may each want to bring something to share, eat and drink together while doing the modules.
- The objective of the campaign is to 'bring finance to life' – so keep discussion light, be kind to and proud of yourselves and one another and have a lot of fun. You are among the most proactive young women around Australia so we are grateful and excited by what we can each and all do once we combine our thoughts, ideas and energy together.

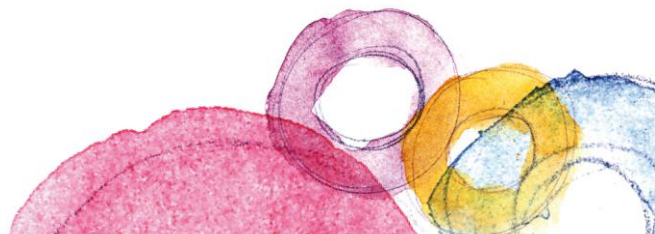
